Day 1 - Arrival

The Temple of Hercules, Amman

The day begins with sightseeing through Amman, the ancient and modern capital of Jordan, originally built on seven hills. From the top of the **Citadel**, one of the highest hills in Amman you have a splendid view of the old city.

You will visit the Citadel, the **Roman Theatre** and the **Archeological** and **Folklore Museums**.

You will then travel to **Jerash**, which is one of the most complete examples of a provincial Roman city to be seen anywhere.

Jerash was one of the cities of the Roman Decapolis, and to this day, its paved and colonnaded streets, soaring hilltop temples, handsome theatres, spacious public squares and plazas, baths, fountains and city walls pierced by towers and gates remain in exceptional condition.

Day 3 - Amman / Madaba / Mount Nebo / Dead Sea



Mount Nebo

First thing this morning you visit **Madaba**, home of the most famous Byzantine Mosaics. See a 6th century map of the holy places in the biblical world.

Continue on to **Mount Nebo** and its spectacular view of the Holy Land.

After Mount Nebo you head to the **Dead Sea**, the lowest point on Earth. At 400 meters (1,312 ft) below the sea level, it is one of the most spectacular natural landscapes in the world. The salinity is 10 times more than the other seas and oceans.

Day 4 - Dead Sea / Petra

Spend the morning relaxing, sunbathing and swimming at the lowest point on earth. Be sure to get “mudded up” to ensure you make the most of your Dead Sea Spa experience.

Early afternoon you then begin the journey to the amazing **Wadi Musa**, commonly known as **Petra**.

Upon arrival, you will begin an unforgettable trip through the Siq (the main entrance) until you reach the **Treasury**. Visit the **Amphitheatre**, the **Triumphal Arch**, **Pharaoh’s Castle**, the **Monastery** and the **Royal Tombs**.

Surely, Petra will be the highlight of your journey!

After farewelling Petra you head to our **Bedouin camp** in **Wadi Rum**.
